Using SatNav

If you are finding us using Sat Nav our postcode is DT8 3SG. This will get you very close to our farm but you may end up at another farm covered by the same postcode - Down Farm.



From Down farm

With Down farm on your right drive about 1/3 mile you'll reach a staggered crossroad. Take the left (sign posted to Maiden Newton).

Dorset Forest Garden will be on your left in about 1/2 mile opposite Kitwhistle Farm.



From Dorchester

- Take A37 signposted to Yeovil
- Just after Grimstone take the left signposted A356 to Crewkerne.
- Follow this road through Frampton & Maiden Newton and climb up the hill.
- After the road flattens out go straight on at crossroads marked Beaminster left and Evershot right then after 1/4 mile take the next left just after a lay-by.
- Follow the lane down for 1/2 mile & Dorset Forest Garden is at the bottom on the right.

By train

The best train stations to arrive at when staying at Dorset Forest Garden is either Maiden Newton or Crewkerne.

We are happy to pick up from either station at no extra charge any time between 5PM and 8PM, please give us a weeks warning with expected arrival time.

Check-in day

The shepherd huts are off-grid and there is no external lighting so please try and arrive and get settled in before dark.

Check-in times during summer clock time are between 3pm and 8pm, and during winter clock time between 3pm and 7pm.

If you are held up for any reason or get lost do let me know. My number is 07971 652501.

Please try to arrive between these hours to avoid disturbing wildlife and other guests.

On arrival

Follow the track up the hill past the farmhouse on the left and forest garden on the right and park up in the yard at the very top in one of the marked parking spaces.

Please call in at the farmhouse and you will be shown to your shepherd's hut.

Departure day

Please leave your shepherd hut and check-out by 11am on departure day, though you can park for longer.

Before you leave, please make sure that all fires are extinguished and the shepherd's hut is as you found it, with everything washed up and put away. Drop in and say good-bye.

If you have broken anything please let me know so we can sort it out.

I also appreciate feedback, so tell me if there is something I could improve on or if there is anything you particularly liked.

Have a safe journey home and I hope to see you again.
